#8834, TFS-140211 -014639, TFS-10075	RESET FAILED LOGINS BUTTON DOESN'T RELOAD PAGE	If a user has forgotten their password and makes too many erroneous login attempts, the failure counter can be reset by clicking the "Reset Failed Logins" button. When this is done, the accompanying text "Too many login failures" is not removed from the page automatically, but only when the page is refreshed (e.g. by pressing F5 in the browser). Note that in FCC 7.0.1, the "Reset Failed Logins" button is moved to the menu button on the User details page.

#8865	ELEMENTS NOT DISPLAYING CORRECTLY WITH IE COMPATIBILITY MODE	The main menu, host details page and other elements do not display correctly in Internet Explorer with Compatibility View active. WORKAROUND: Do not activate Compatibility View for FCC in Internet Explorer.
