Table 4: Known Issues in BoKS SSH Client 7.1.3

Issue #	Title	Description
#9404	BROWSE HISTORY KEYBOARD NAVIGATION INCONSISTENT	When you navigate through the local and remote browse history using the up and down arrows on your keyboard, the list does not stop at the home folder but cycles through the browse locations.
#9403	NAVIGATING TO PREVIOUSLY VISITED FOLDER FAILS WHEN SHORT-CUT LINK IS SELECTED	In the remote browse history, when the short-cut link is selected it redirects to the folder that the link is pointing to, but when you try to go back from the current folder to the previously visited folder using the remote toolbar's "Back" button, the operation fails. Also when new folders are browsed later and you click "Back", navigation stops at the folder the short-cut link pointed to and hitting the "Back" button twice renders the "Forward" button unavailable.
#9353	NEW FOLDER CREATED IN CURRENT SELECTED TREE NODE, NOT RIGHT-CLICKED NODE	When you create a new folder in the local / remote tree view by right-clicking and selecting New Folder , the new folder is created in the currently selected tree node, not the tree node that you right-clicked.
#9352	SUB-FOLDER NOT VISIBLE IN LOCAL TREE VIEW	A sub-folder that is created in the local list view is not seen in the local tree view until and unless the root folder is manually refreshed.
#8839	OLD CLIENT STILL INSTALLED AFTER UPGRADE	If the type of installation you select when upgrading is different to the type of installation for the previous version, the old version is not uninstalled. For example, if you installed the 6.6 client for "everyone" and the upgrade for "just me", the 6.6 client is not removed, and vice versa.
#8808	SELECTING CERTIFICATE WITHOUT USERNAME BLOCKS USER SELECTION	In BoKSSHWin, if a user does not enter a username but selects a certificate, the program does not contact csspd to determine a login name from the certificate, and cannot determine which user account should attempt to log in.
#8183	FALLBACK TO PUBLIC KEY WHEN x509 FAILS DOES NOT WORK	When Bageant is not used, and a user has configured both a private key file and a personal certificate for authentication (using the SSH > Auth dialog box), if certificate authentication fails the private key file should then be tried for authentication. However there is no functioning fallback to the private key in this case.
